On November 14, 2020, at approximately 10am, Menifee Police Officers and Cal-Fire personnel responded to the area of Holland Road and Evans Road, for a major injury traffic collision involving two vehicles. Upon arrival, officers located two vehicles, a black Chevrolet truck and a Grey Pontiac Sedan. The driver, and solo occupant of the truck, suffered minor injuries and was treated at the scene.

The grey sedan had three occupants. The driver suffered severe injuries and was transported immediately to the hospital in stable condition. The remaining two passengers were trapped inside of the vehicle and Cal-Fire was able to extricate them. Both passengers, one of them a juvenile, were transported to local hospitals, and they remain in critical condition with life threatening injuries.

During the investigation, it was determined there was possibly a large group of bicyclists in the area that may have witnessed the incident. Also, there may be an unidentified third vehicle involved in this collision, described only as a white Scion Xb. We are asking for those who may have witnessed the collision, or who have any information about the collision to contact Sergeant Bloch of the Menifee Police Department at (951) 723-1565, or you can contact the front desk at (951) 723-1500.

Alcohol and drugs do not appear to be a factor at this time. The roadway remained closed for several hours pending an investigation by the Traffic Unit.

The Menifee Police Department would like to remind the public that in California, you are required to provide certain information to the other parties involved. Likewise, fellow motorists, passengers and pedestrians involved in the accident must share similar information. This information includes: Name, address and contact details; Valid CA driver license number; License plate number of the vehicles involved; and auto insurance or other evidence of financial responsibility.
