Major Injury Traffic Collision

On February 6, 2022, at approximately 2224 hours, Menifee Police Department responded to the area of Highway 74 and Trumble Road, for a vehicle versus motorcycle collision. Upon arrival, officers located the motorcycle rider who was in critical condition. Officers provided life saving measures until Cal-Fire and American Medical Response personnel arrived. The subject was transported to Inland Valley Medical Center where he remained in critical condition. The driver of the vehicle remained on scene and cooperated with the investigation,

The preliminary investigation revealed that the vehicle, a Toyota pick-up truck was traveling eastbound on Highway 74, while the motorcycle, a Harley Davidson, was traveling westbound on Highway 74. The Toyota then made a left turn in front of the Harley Davidson and a collision occurred. The driver of the Toyota, identified as 31-year-old Nathan Stipp, was arrested for Driving Under the Influence and causing great bodily injury. The roadways remained closed for several hours while officers investigated the collision.
