37 Drivers, Motorcyclists Cited During Motorcycle Safety Enforcement Operation

Menifee, Calif. – Menifee Police Department cited 37 drivers and motorcycle riders for a variety of violations.

During the operation February 28th from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. , 16 drivers were cited for red light/stop sign violations, 9 drivers were cited speeding, 6 cited for cell phone usage, and 6 for improper turns. All of these violations committed by motorcyclists and passenger cars can be extremely dangerous to all drivers on the road.

Menifee Police Department will hold another motorcycle safety enforcement in the coming months however, the date(s) have not been determined yet.
