MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION

Menifee, CA – On March 21, 2024, at 11:36 P.M., the Menifee Police Department responded to a report of a traffic collision near the intersection of Newport Road and Menifee Road, involving a Toyota sedan and a Harley Davidson motorcycle.

Upon arrival, officers located a downed motorcycle and rider in the westbound lanes of Newport Road near Stater Way, who sustained severe injuries.

The Toyota was located stopped in the eastbound turn lane on Newport Road and Stater Way, which was occupied by the driver, who sustained minor injuries.

Both parties were transported to a local hospital for their injuries. The motorcycle rider was listed in critical condition. The Menifee Police Department Traffic Unit arrived on scene and assumed the investigation.

Officers determined both the Toyota and the Harley Davidson were traveling eastbound on Newport Road when the Harley Davidson struck the rear end of the Toyota. At this time, alcohol is believed to be a factor in the collision; however, the exact cause of the collision is still under investigation. Officers are seeking to identify anyone who may have witnessed this collision.
