2 arrested at Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

Menifee, CA. –113 vehicles were screened while conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, April 13th, 2024. The checkpoint was held on Menifee Rd and McCall Blvd from approximately 7 PM to 10 PM. One was arrested for DUI combo alcohol/drugs, and two drivers were cited for operating a vehicle unlicensed or with a suspended/revoked license. One offender was arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia. Due to weather conditions, the checkpoint was shut down prior to the previously scheduled time.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired. Any driver can make the decision not to drink and drive by simply not doing it.

Impaired driving remains a top safety concern for the residents of Menifee and the Menifee Police Department as well. Please drink responsibly and avoid the hefty fines of a DUI arrest.

The Menifee Police Department will hold more DUI/Driver's License checkpoints in 2024, dates will be announced in the near future.
