FOUR ARRESTED AT MENIFEE DUI/DL CHECKPOINT

Menifee, CA – 1,368 vehicles were screened while conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, June 8, 2024. The checkpoint was held on Newport Road near Winter Hawk Road from approximately 7:00 PM to 2:00 AM. Four were arrested for alcohol DUI's, one driver for DUI alcohol and drugs, and three drivers were cited for operating a vehicle unlicensed or with a suspended/revoked license.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

Impaired driving remains a top safety concern for the residents of Menifee and the Menifee Police Department as well. Please drink responsibly and avoid the hefty fines of a DUI arrest.

The Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint, a date will be announced in the near future.
