30 Drivers, Motorcyclists Cited During Motorcycle Safety Enforcement Operation

Menifee, CA – Menifee Police Department cited 30 drivers and motorcycle riders for a variety of violations. 3 motorcycle riders were stopped and found to not have a motorcycle endorsement as a result the motorcycles were towed.

During the operation on Wednesday May 29th from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. , six drivers were cited for red light/stop sign violations, 18 drivers were cited speeding, six cited for cell phone usage, and six for improper turns. All of these violations committed by motorcyclists and passenger cars can be extremely dangerous to all drivers on the road. Additionally, a driver was stopped for speeding, but he attempted to flee from the officer and pulled into a random driveway to evade police. The driver was arrested for reckless driving and resisting, delaying an officer in his/her duties; his vehicle was also towed for 30 days.

Menifee Police Department will hold another motorcycle safety enforcement in the coming months however, the date(s) have not been determined yet.
