3 Arrested at Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

Menifee, CA – 591 vehicles screened, one arrested for DUI, one arrested for driving on a suspended license for DUI, and one arrested for a Felony warrant while conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, August 24, 2024.

The checkpoint was held near the intersection of McCall Blvd. and Sun City Blvd. from 7pm to 2am. Six drivers were cited for operating a vehicle unlicensed or with a suspended/revoked license, two offenders were arrested for other criminal charges.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

The Menifee Police Department is 100% committed to preventing, deterring, and arresting impaired drivers in Menifee and it will continue to be a top priority.

The Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on a date to be determined.
