PROWLER ARREST

Menifee, CA –The Menifee Police Department was made aware of several incidents involving a male subject who was described as roaming local apartment complexes while attempting to locate unlocked front doors. These incidents took place during early morning hours. In one reported incident, the subject entered an occupied home through an unlocked door, but guickly fled when the residents awoke.

Several recordings of this individual were shared on social media platforms, including Nextdoor and Ring.

During the early morning hours of September 26, 2024, while conducting surveillance in the area of Park Plaza Avenue and Town Center Drive in the City of Menifee, Detectives observed a subject matching the description of the person described in the previously reported incidents. When Detectives attempted to contact the subject, he fled, and a short foot chase occurred before he was taken into custody.

The subject was identified as Irving William Firtha-Morrison, an adult resident of Menifee who was placed under arrest for Prowling, Burglary and Resisting Arrest. He was later booked at the Cois Byrd Detention Center.

The Menifee Police Department urges residents to keep their doors locked, even while at home, and to report any suspicious activity directly to police dispatch at our non-emergency number at (951) 677- 4964 or by dialing 9-1-1 for emergencies.
