Menifee, CA – On Saturday, October 5, 2024, the Menifee Police Department will team up with MilVet, faith-based organizations, and community members for the National Faith and Blue event, supporting active-duty military personnel and first responders. The event will take place at the Kay Cenicerros Senior Center (29995 Evans Rd., Menifee, CA 92586) from 1 to 4 PM.

Attendees will have the opportunity to help assemble 200 care packages for deployed military members. In addition, local veterans and first responders can explore various available resources to address their unique needs.

The Menifee Police Department encourages the entire community to join the event on October 5th. For those unable to attend, donations are welcome year-round at both the Menifee and Sun City Libraries during business hours.
