4 Arrested at Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

Menifee, CA – While conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, November 9, 2024, 258 vehicles were screened, 2 arrested for DUI, 1 arrested for driving on a suspended license for DUI and a warrant. 1 driver was arrested for weapons charges after making an illegal U-turn to avoid the checkpoint.

The checkpoint was held near the intersection of Scott Road and Lindenberger Road from 7pm to 2am. 12 drivers were cited for various vehicle code violations; 5 of those were drivers who were unlicensed. During this checkpoint 6 vehicles were towed.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

The Menifee Police Department is 100% committed to preventing, deterring, and arresting impaired driver in Menifee and will continue to be a top priority.

The Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on Saturday, December 14, 2024.
