## HIT AND RUN TRAFFIC COLLISION

**Menifee, CA –** On November 17, 2024, at approximately 6:40 PM, Menifee Police Officers responded to a traffic collision near the intersection of Ethanac Road and Sherman Road involving two vehicles and a female pedestrian.

Upon investigation, it was determined that the woman was initially hit by one vehicle while walking on the road's shoulder. After she fell onto the roadway, a second vehicle traveling in the opposite direction struck her. Neither driver stopped at the scene or contacted law enforcement to provide information. The victim was transported to a medical facility for treatment of her injuries, which are not considered to be life-threatening.

Currently, the only description of the involved vehicles is an SUV-style vehicle and an unidentified model sedan.

It is unknown whether alcohol or drugs were factors in the collision. The exact cause remains under investigation.
