## 7 Drivers Cited for Being Unlicensed At Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

**Menifee, CA** – 1,215 vehicles screened, no arrests were made for DUI, 7 drivers cited for being unlicensed while conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, December 14, 2024.

The checkpoint was held near the intersection of Newport Road and Winter Hawk Road from 7pm to 2am. 17 drivers were cited for various vehicle code violations observed around the checkpoint area.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

The Menifee Police Department is 100% committed to preventing, deterring, and arresting impaired driver in Menifee and will continue to be a top priority.

Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on a date to be determined.
