MAJOR TRAFFIC COLLISION

Menifee, CA – On December 31, 2024, at approximately 4:57 P.M., Menifee police officers responded to a report of a vehicle versus motorcycle collision near the intersection of Newport Road and Lone Pine Drive. The motorcycle then collided with cable communication boxes.

Upon arrival, officers located a Toyota Rav4 and Honda CBR600, both with major collision damage. It was determined the Toyota was being driven by a 40-year-old female and occupied by a 75-year-old female passenger. Both sustained non-life-threatening injuries and were cooperative with the investigation. The motorcycle was being driven by a 20-year-old male. As a result of the collision, the rider of the motorcycle was ejected and sustained life-threatening injuries. Cal Fire and American Medical Response (AMR) responded and provided medical aid at scene. The rider was transported to a medical facility where he was listed in critical condition.

Menifee Police Traffic Unit responded and took over the investigation. All parties are current Menifee residents. At this time, alcohol or drugs do not appear to be a factor. The cause of the collision is still under investigation.
