1 Arrested at Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

Menifee, CA – 465 vehicles were screened, and 1 driver was arrested for DUI Drugs while conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, February 1, 2025. The driver was also charged with being in possession of a switch blade and drug paraphernalia. Additionally, 2 drivers were cited for operating a vehicle unlicensed.

The checkpoint was held near the intersection of McCall Boulevard and Sun City Boulevard from 7pm to 2am. Officers were also in the area of the checkpoint conducting traffic stops for various vehicle code violations. During the checkpoint hours 58 stops were conducted, and 35 citations were written.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

The Menifee Police Department is 100% committed to preventing, deterring, and arresting impaired driver in Menifee and will continue to be a top priority.

The Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on a date to be determined.
