## MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION

**Menifee, CA –** On May 18, 2025, at about 6:53 P.M., the Menifee Police Department responded to a two-vehicle traffic crash on Hwy 74 near 3<sup>rd</sup> Street involving a gray Nissan Altima and white Ford Windstar. The reporting party stated that in addition to the two vehicles, a pedestrian was also struck and had a severe head injury.

CAL FIRE and AMR responded to the scene and the adult male pedestrian was transported to a local hospital for treatment of major head injuries. The Menifee Police Department Traffic Unit arrived and assumed the investigation.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the Ford Windstar was making a northbound turn onto 3<sup>rd</sup> Street from eastbound Highway 74. The gray Nissan Altima was traveling westbound on Hwy 74. The Ford Windstar collied into the Nissan Altima as the Windstar was making a left turn. The Nissan Altima was forced onto the sidewalk and struck a pedestrian. The driver of the Nissan had minor injuries and the driver of the Windstar did not sustain any injuries. The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital and was admitted to the trauma unit. The pedestrian is in stable condition and is awaiting surgery for his injuries. Drugs or alcohol do not appear to be a factor in the crash.
