MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION

Menifee, CA – On May 18, 2025, at about 6:53 P.M., the Menifee Police Department responded to a two-vehicle traffic crash on Hwy 74 near 3rd Street involving a gray Nissan Altima and white Ford Windstar. The reporting party stated that in addition to the two vehicles, a pedestrian was also struck and had a severe head injury.

CAL FIRE and AMR responded to the scene and the adult male pedestrian was transported to a local hospital for treatment of major head injuries. The Menifee Police Department Traffic Unit arrived and assumed the investigation.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the Ford Windstar was making a northbound turn onto 3rd Street from eastbound Highway 74. The gray Nissan Altima was traveling westbound on Hwy 74. The Ford Windstar collided into the Nissan Altima as the Windstar was making a left turn. The Nissan Altima was forced onto the sidewalk and struck a pedestrian. The driver of the Nissan had minor injuries and the driver of the Windstar did not sustain any injuries. The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital and was admitted to the trauma unit. The pedestrian is in stable condition and is awaiting surgery for his injuries. Drugs or alcohol do not appear to be a factor in the crash.
