2 Arrested and 17 Cited at Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

Menifee, CA – Two arrested and 17 cited for driving with suspended/revoked license or without a license while conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, May 17, 2025. During the checkpoint 437 vehicles were screened at the location.

The checkpoint was held near the intersection of Menifee Road and McCall Boulevard from 7pm to 2am. 17 drivers were cited for various vehicle violations and two for operating a vehicle unlicensed or with a suspended/revoked license, two offenders were arrested for other criminal charges, including outstanding warrants.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

The Menifee Police Department is committed to preventing, deterring, and arresting impaired drivers in Menifee and it will continue to be a top priority.

The Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on a date to be determined.
