MAJOR TRAFFIC COLLISION

Menifee, CA – On August 7, 2025, at approximately 12:32 a.m., the Menifee Police Department responded to a single-vehicle traffic collision at the intersection of Goetz Road and Goldenrod Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers located a Chrysler 300 with significant damage and found a 40-year-old female outside of the vehicle who was the only occupant. CAL FIRE and AMR responded to the scene. The female driver was transported to a local hospital for treatment. The driver sustained moderate injuries and is listed in stable condition. The Menifee Police Department's Traffic Unit responded to the scene and assumed the investigation.

Preliminary findings indicate that the vehicle was traveling north on Goetz Road when, for unknown reasons, it veered to the right into the dirt shoulder. The vehicle veered back into the roadway, losing control and rolling over several times, causing the driver to be ejected from the sunroof. Alcohol is suspected to have been a contributing factor in the collision.
