OFFICERS RESPOND TO SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT

Menifee, CA – On Tuesday, October 7, 2025, at 6:35 AM, officers from the Menifee Police Department responded to a report of a possible suicide threat in the parking lot of Menifee Global Hospital. Hospital staff reported receiving a phone call from a male stating he was in the parking lot and intended to take his own life. The reporting party stated the male also claimed he would shoot anyone who attempted to approach his vehicle.

The call abruptly ended with what sounded like a gunshot. The hospital was immediately placed on lockdown and nearby Han Christensen Middle School activated their “secure campus” protocol to include securing all campus doors and students inside. Responding officers immediately worked to thoroughly search the parking lot and hospital and determined there was no active threat or suicidal subject located on the property.

The Menifee Police Department takes all threats to public safety seriously and appreciates the swift cooperation of hospital staff, school personnel, and community members during this incident.
