MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC CRASH

Menifee, CA – On October 21, 2025, at approximately 10:17 p.m., the Menifee Police Department responded to a two-vehicle traffic collision at the intersection of Scott Road and Daily Road. Upon arrival, officers located a Toyota Truck and BMW motorcycle both with major damage.

The driver of the truck, a 65-year-old resident of Menifee, did not report any injuries and waited at the scene for law enforcement to arrive. The motorcycle rider, a 46-year-old resident of Paramount, was wearing a helmet but sustained severe injuries. He was transported by AMR to a local hospital for treatment, where he remains in critical condition.

The Menifee Police Department's Traffic Unit responded to the scene and assumed the investigation. Preliminary findings indicated the driver of the truck was traveling west on Scott Road, negotiating a left turn onto Daily Road. The motorcycle rider was traveling east on Scott Road when he crashed into the truck and was thrown from the motorcycle. The primary collision factor is still under investigation. Alcohol and/or drugs do not appear to have been a contributing factor in the crash.
