## **MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC CRASH**

**Menifee, CA** – On November 16, 2025, at approximately 12:06 a.m., the Menifee Police Department responded to a solo-vehicle traffic collision at the intersection of McCall Boulevard and Menifee Road. Upon arrival, officers located a BMW sedan fully engulfed in flames and the driver had been removed from the vehicle.

The driver of the sedan, a 20-year-old resident of Menifee, was removed from the vehicle by witnesses and had sustained major burns to parts of his body. The male was transported to a medical facility for treatment of his injuries. As of November 16, 2025, at approximately 5:00 p.m., the male was in stable condition.

The Menifee Police Department's Traffic Unit conducted a follow-up investigation into the crash. Preliminary findings indicate the BMW was traveling westbound on McCall Boulevard when it struck the center median, crossed over it, and then hit the south curb before colliding with a tree. The impact caused the vehicle to catch fire. Investigators believe alcohol may have contributed to the collision, along with wet roadway conditions caused by the rain.
