MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC CRASH

Menifee, CA — The Menifee Police Department is investigating a traffic collision that occurred on December 1, 2025, at approximately 9:36 p.m. near the intersection of Murrieta Road and Murphy Ranch Road. The incident involved a Honda Civic and a juvenile male riding a manual, non-motorized skateboard.

Officers arrived on scene within minutes, locating the injured juvenile and the vehicle's driver, an adult female resident of Menifee. The driver sustained minor injuries that did not require medical treatment. The juvenile, who was not wearing a helmet, was thrown from the skateboard upon impact and sustained injuries to his head along with abrasions to his hands and arms.

Medical personnel treated him at the scene before transporting him to a local hospital where he remains in critical but stable condition.

The Menifee Police Department Traffic Unit responded and assumed the investigation. Preliminary findings indicate the juvenile was traveling in the southbound lane of Murrieta Road without lighting or reflective gear when he was struck. The driver immediately stopped to render aid, and a passenger in the vehicle called 911. At this time, investigators do not believe drugs or alcohol are contributing factors.
