## 2 Arrested and 24 cited at Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

**Menifee, CA** – 1,370 vehicles were screened, 1 individual arrested for DUI Alcohol and 1 individual arrested for DUI Drugs while conducting a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, December 13, 2025. Additionally, 66 vehicles were stopped for various violations and 24 citations were issued.

The checkpoint was held near the intersection of Newport Road and Murrieta Road from 7pm to 2am. 8 drivers were cited for operating a vehicle unlicensed and 3 vehicles were towed.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

The Menifee Police Department is 100% committed to preventing, deterring, and arresting impaired drivers in Menifee and it will continue to be a top priority.

The Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on a date to be determined.
