MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC CRASH

Menifee, CA — On Friday, December 19, 2025, at approximately 5:31 p.m., officers from the Menifee Police Department responded to the area of Bradley Road, south of McCall Boulevard, regarding a reported vehicle versus pedestrian collision.

The incident was reported by an uninvolved party who heard the crash but did not witness it. After hearing the collision, the caller approached the scene and observed an adult male driver rendering aid on a pedestrian who was lying in the roadway. The driver informed the caller that he did not have a cellular phone and requested assistance contacting emergency services. The caller then dialed 911 to report the collision.

Upon arrival, officers located a 1999 Mercury Villager stopped in the southbound lanes of Bradley Road. An adult male pedestrian was found in the roadway suffering from major head injuries and abrasions to his hands and arms. The driver of the vehicle, an 86-year-old male resident of Menifee remained on scene and was the sole occupant of the vehicle.

Cal Fire personnel arrived and immediately began providing medical treatment to the victim. Due to the severity of the injuries, the pedestrian was transported to a local medical center for further care. The victim sustained serious head injuries, and at the time of this release the is listed in unstable condition.

The Menifee Police Department Traffic Unit responded and assumed responsibility for the investigation. Preliminary findings indicate the driver was traveling southbound on Bradley Road when he did not see the pedestrian crossing the roadway and struck him.

At this stage of the investigation, alcohol or drugs do not appear to be factors in the collision. The investigation remains ongoing.
