6 Arrested at Menifee DUI/DL Checkpoint

Menifee, CA – During a DUI/DL checkpoint on Saturday, February 21, 2026, 497 vehicles were screened and 6 individuals were arrested.

The checkpoint was held near the intersection of McCall Boulevard and Sun City Boulevard from 7PM to 2AM. 4 drivers were arrested for DUI, and 2 others were arrested for drug possession. Additionally, 4 drivers were cited for operating a vehicle unlicensed or with a suspended license.

Checkpoint locations are based on a history of crashes and DUI arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring drivers from driving impaired.

The Menifee Police Department is 100% committed to preventing, deterring, and arresting, impaired drivers in Menifee and it will continue to be a top priority.

The Menifee Police Department will hold another DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on a date to be determined.
