Two Arrested for Selling Alcohol & Drugs to Minors

Menifee, CA – In February 2026, a Menifee Police Officer received information that an adult female was selling alcohol, nicotine vape pens, THC vape pens, and mushrooms to minors. Officers initiated an investigation and identified the suspect as Yuridia Guerrero, a resident of San Jacinto.

On March 17, 2026, with assistance from the Menifee Police Department Special Enforcement Team, officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle occupied by Guerrero and Kevin Ocegueda, also an adult San Jacinto resident. A search of the vehicle revealed bags of nicotine and THC vape pens, and both were taken into custody. Officers subsequently served a search warrant at Guerrero's residence, where additional evidence was located.

Both suspects were charged with selling marijuana to minors, contributing to the delinquency of a minor, furnishing tobacco to minors, and selling alcohol to minors. Both were booked at the Cois M. Byrd Detention Center.

The investigation also revealed the suspects were communicating with minors through social media platforms. The Menifee Police Department strongly encourages parents to actively monitor their children's social media use and online interactions.
