## **DEATH INVESTIGATION**

**Menifee, CA** – On Saturday, April 25, 2026, at approximately 6:46 p.m., officers from the Menifee Police Department responded to a residential alarm in the 21900 block of Moraga Street in the City of Menifee. Officers determined that a concerned neighbor had accidentally triggered the residential alarm when he entered the residence to check on the wellbeing of his neighbor whom he had not seen for several weeks.

Upon entering the residence, officers discovered 57-year-old Derrick Osbey deceased in an advanced state of decomposition.

Due to the condition in which Mr. Osbey was found a cause of death was unable to be determined, therefore, the Riverside County Coroner and Menifee Police Department Investigators were notified to assume the investigation.

Preliminary investigation indicates that this is an isolated incident and there is no threat to the public. Investigators are awaiting autopsy results; at this time this incident remains an active investigation.
